Dave is the Chair of the S300A Subcommittee at the Underwriters' Laboratories of Canada with responsibilities for National Standards of Canada CAN/ULC-S301 and CAN/ULC-S304 – Burglar Alarm Standards. He also is the Working Group Chair of the CAN/ULC-S561, a National Standard of Canada for the Monitoring of Fire Alarm and Fire Suppression Sprinkler Systems.
